Background

Reporting to the ICT Development team lead, the web developer will deliver solutions to support UNOPS users around the world. The developer will be a part of a dynamic development team utilizing agile/scrum based software development processes. Emphasis is put on creative problem solving, collaboration with users, and fostering an active knowledge sharing environment.

The UNOPS development team's role is to provide the organization with tools and resources to compliment and support the SharePoint 2007- based corporate Intranet, SharePoint 2007- based corporate Website and UNOPS' ERP system. System development domains include eProcurement, knowledge management, reporting, and contracts review.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop and test web applications that support corporate business systems infrastructure; develop systems that adhere to the product and service needs of internal clients.
- Propose and collaborate on system application approaches (custom Web Parts, .Net applications, User controls, etc)
- Implement solutions compliant with UNOPS solution approach
